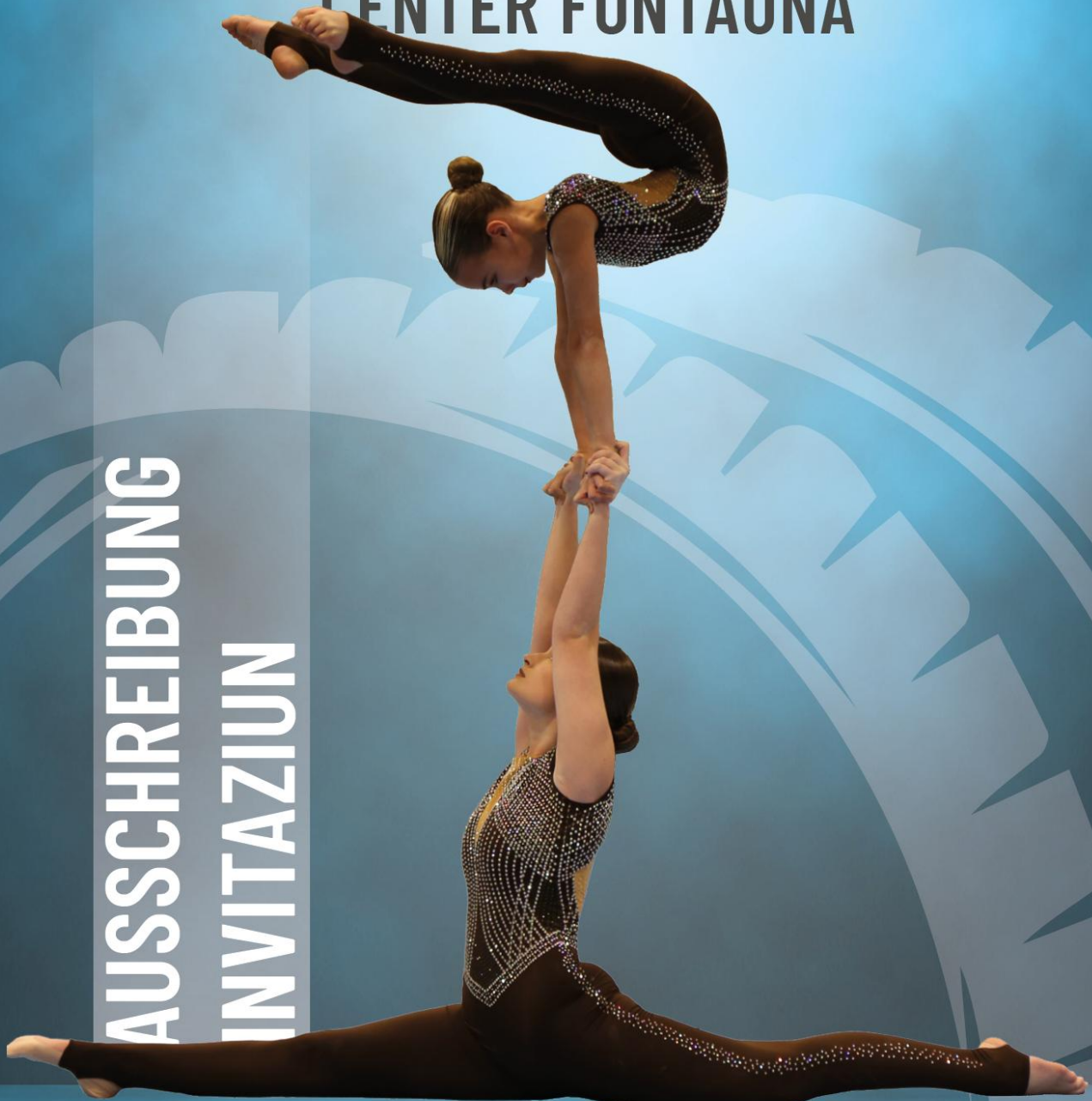

5. Competition format / age limit

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the FIG guidelines for Pre-Youth, Youth, Juniors and Seniors, as well as the SVAT regulations for SN1, SN2, Aspire and SNO. Multiple entries per person are not permitted. We ask clubs to register their teams in the correct categories.

Category	Age limit	Routine requirements
SN1	5–13 years	Combined exercise according to SVAT
SN2	6–14 years	Combined exercise based on SVAT
Aspire	8–16 years	Combined exercise based on SVAT
SNO	No age limit, maximum age difference between partners 12 years	Combined exercise according to SVAT
Pre-Youth	9–16 years	Balance, speed & combination exercises according to FIG
Youth	10–18 years	Balance, speed and combination exercises according to FIG
Juniors	11–19 years	Balance, speed & combination exercises according to FIG
Seniors	aged 13 and over	Balance, speed & combination exercises according to FIG

Developed in accordance with the following FIG regulations:

- Code of Points (2025–2028)
- ACRO Youth & Junior Rules (2025–2028)
- Table of Difficulty (2025–2028)
- The current competition regulations of the FIG and the SVAT apply

6. Judging Panel

Only judges who have obtained a National Certificate and/or the FIG Certificate in the current year are authorised to judge.

Each club must register at least one judge. From 8 registered units onwards, a second judge must be provided.

The registered judges must be available for all categories and days.

Judges may be exchanged between clubs, but a judge may only judge for one club per competition.

If the judging requirement is not met, the organiser is entitled to recruit a judge themselves and to charge the resulting costs (transport, accommodation) to the club that has failed to meet the minimum requirement. An additional expense allowance of CHF 250 will also be charged. The organiser will endeavour to recruit replacement judges at reasonable cost.

7. Registration, entry fee and payment terms

Tariff sheets and music

Tariff sheets and music must be submitted via Acro Companion by **13 November 2026** at the latest.

Entry fees

The entry fee is **CHF 45.00 per athlete**.

Payment terms

Entry fees and catering costs must be paid in full to the account below by the final registration deadline (**21 August 2026**).

No refunds will be given for payments made after final registration!
