- The competition is governed by the current regulations of the WG and the SVAT

Judges

- Only judges who have obtained the SVAT licence and/or the WG licence in the current year are entitled to judge.
- Each club/performance centre must register at least one judge.
- From eight (8) registered units, a second judge must be provided.
- The registered judges must be available for the entire competition and not only for the categories in which the club's athletes compete.
- The judging obligation is only considered fulfilled if the required minimum number of judges is registered for each competition session.
- Judges may be exchanged between clubs/performance centres; however, a judge may only judge for one club/performance centre per competition.
- If the judging obligation is not fulfilled, the organiser is entitled to recruit a judge and to charge the resulting costs (transport, accommodation) to the club that does not meet the minimum. In addition, an administrative fine of 250.- CHF will be levied.

- The maximum costs that can be charged amount to 500.- CHF. The organiser endeavours to recruit substitute judges at reasonable cost.

Athletes' meals

A meal is offered to the registered delegations on Saturday and Sunday at lunchtime
